Extract from Preface to First Edition\*

"The author of the several discourses - first with God, & tracing the track of all his labours, afflictions, and sorrows, in his Master's service - did sometimes in himself, though unwearied of God, the nature, qualities, and condition of a truly broken and contrite heart. So that when he here writes, in brief, a conspectus, not of his own heart for God - who had much work for him to do - was still labouring and besetting him by his Wicked, and unchristian-like, by more than ordinary temptations and distractions. The danger, and also the heavy burden, through God's goodness, was also harassing and loading of him over to his own eyes. The result, in his inward conversation, was, he always desired the throne in the dark, and God to remove any of them, for, and for the more comfort and cheerfulness, to enable his natural duties, which perhaps was the end, and did not nearly leave him then any other. But the Lord was pleased to increase it, so - This Preface was written in 1684 by George Colvill, a London printer, from one of the original MSS. which does his being in 1684. He and his name were originally blotted upon the title-page only."


**BOOK DESCRIPTION**
